



# FUNdraising with Flying High!!!

## Your FUNdraiser will include:

- Exclusive use of the facility !!!
- 60ft Inflatable Obstacle Course, Open Gym Time, Games
- Pizza and Lemonade
- Remember, parents do not have to stay for the event, volunteer, or clean up! We take care of EVERYTHING for you!

## How it works:

A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 will book your FUNdraiser Event. This deposit will secure your date/time for your fundraiser. You pick your date on our website and submit your deposit online via credit card or check. Due to high demand, we are unable to hold spots without securing the \$100.00 deposit.

Once a deposit is secured, that date/time is yours!

***\*MINIMUM # OF ATTENDEES: 15 (because PFRs are in high demand, and there are a limited number offered throughout the year, events with fewer than 15 at 11:59pm two days prior to the event, will be cancelled and the deposit will be forfeited).***

## Earn your deposit back!

- \*Under 25 registrations – no donation
- \*25-59 registrations – 50% of deposit donated back to the school/organization
- \*Over 60 – Full deposit donated back to the organization

\* We at Flying High are aware that these Pizza FUNdraisers can be a GREAT way to raise funds for your organization, however, we want you to always be able to tailor your event to suit your needs! Your organization has the option to designate your Pizza FUNdraiser as a PUBLIC or PRIVATE event. If you would like to designate your Pizza FUNdraiser Night as PUBLIC, Flying High will include your event on our general monthly newsletter that is available to the public. Flying High will also post on our social media pages promoting your event. This option offers an additional marketing strategy to bring more attendees to your event. Designating your Pizza FUNdraiser as PRIVATE allows you to limit your event to the people you share it with. These events will be designated as PRIVATE on Flying High's monthly newsletter and there will be no social media posts. Designations must be made upon booking to give FH ample time to add it to our monthly newsletter.

## Pricing and Registration:

- Online Registration will open immediately upon booking your event, and your flyer will be emailed to you for distribution approximately 6 weeks before your event. If you have any

- Parents will register their children for the event on our website. Pre-registration discount is \$18/child; our **pre-registration** discount ends at 11:59pm two days prior to your event. Register after the discount period for \$22/child online or at the door.
- Registrations for Pizza FUNdraisers are non-refundable. Parents should contact the school or organization contact for reimbursement.

### You will raise:

- \$6.00 per child during your event!

#### Traveling South down LaGrange Road:

Travel South down LaGrange to 55<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn left (East) onto 55<sup>th</sup> street. After traveling East on 55<sup>th</sup> Street for approximately five blocks, turn left (North) at the light at East Avenue. When you reach 5400 East Avenue, turn left into our parking lot. You will see a large sign in front of our building.

#### Traveling North down LaGrange Road:

Travel down LaGrange Road to 55<sup>th</sup> street. Turn right (east) onto 55<sup>th</sup> street. Travel on 55<sup>th</sup> street for approximately 5 blocks. Turn left (North) at the light on East Avenue. When you reach 5400 East Avenue, turn left into our parking lot. You will see a large sign in front of our building.



### Things to Know!

Our Events Staff knows and understands all the Flying High safety rules. To ensure a safe event, we ask that all children as well as adults respect our staff's authority.

- No parents allowed in the gym for safety/security/space reasons; parents are more than welcome to stay in the upstairs viewing room during the event. Due to pizza being served in the Viewing Room, parents will be unable to gather in that room during serving time.
- We ask that children be dressed in gym clothes; no zippers on clothing, no dangling earrings and/or jewelry.
- Parents do not have to stay for the duration of the event, volunteer, or clean up!
- After registration, children will be asked to place all their belongings in our cubbies (shoes, jackets, etc). Cell phones, and other electronics should not be brought into our foam pits.
- We ask that everyone remove their shoes before entering the gym area.
- "Flying High strives to be a place where kiddos can feel comfortable, be themselves, be fit and active, and HAVE FUN. During all events, Flying High maintains a ZERO CONTACT policy between children, unless within the context of instructor guided group activity. As a result, ANY roughhousing at Events is strictly forbidden, even if the way it is displayed is playful. Any children roughhousing will be removed from the gym and parents called for pickup via the number listed on the completed waiver."
- **All guests must have a waiver on file through our online waiver system. This waiver can be found on the main page of our website <https://www.flyinghighgym.com/countryside/waiver>.**
- We will work with one point of contact for your school/group/organization for your event. This point of contact will be responsible for relaying all information to your PTO/FSA, School Board, etc.
- You will receive a completed "sample flyer" to approve before distribution approximately 6 weeks prior to your event. If you would like your flyer sooner, please do not hesitate to email and let us know! Based on experience, the below suggested timeline of publication seems to maximize attendance:
  1. Place event date(s) on school calendars upon booking.
  2. Approximately 4 weeks before event: First flyer distribution via hard copies, social media, and organization website
  3. Approximately 2 weeks before event: Second flyer distribution.
  4. Approximately 1 week before event: Email blast or social media push
  5. The Tuesday before your event: social media reminder!

- Your school/group/organization will receive an email of your FUNdraiser results after your event, and you will receive a check in the amount of the funds, which will be postmarked and mailed within approximately 2 weeks of your event. Times vary, but please do not hesitate to contact us for an update at any time!
