Junior Camp Counselor Summer Program

Program Summary:

The Jr. Camp Counselor Program is a special opportunity for 13-14 year olds to learn the skills needed to work with children in the Flying High camp setting. This is an educational program, with curricula designed for the participant to develop the technical skills necessary to be an effective camp counselor. The Jr. Camp Counselor Program will provide basic training in first aid, group leadership, problem solving, time management and more! A Jr. Camp Counselor is a camper and therefore must follow many of the same rules and restrictions as our regular campers. We require that the Jr. Counselor pay the yearly \$35 administration fee. Since the Jr. Camp Counselor is a training program, the participant will receive 50% off full week of camp with field trip option. Participation in this program does not automatically guarantee a future staff position here at Flying High, however, it does pave the way for possible employment. The ultimate goal of this program is to give the Jr. Camp Counselor the necessary skills to be a successful future Camp Counselor. Participants will also be able to apply the skills learned in this program to future babysitting positions and leadership roles in the academic setting. At the end of the program, the participant will receive a certificate of completion and a letter of recommendation.

How are Jr Camp Counselor Chosen?

The program will be limited to no more than 10 Jr Camp Counselor per summer and admittance is through a competitive process that will include a written component and an interview process. Forms for applying to this program are available at our locations or on the Summer Camp page of our website. A parent or legal guardian must also complete our online camp registration.

It is important that the applicant shows initiative by calling or emailing the camp director expressing his/her interest in the program. He or she should carefully complete all of the application material and return the packet to the Camp Director. All essay-type questions should be in the applicant's own words and typed or neatly handwritten. Once the application and references are reviewed, a formal in person interview will be scheduled by the camp director with those selected. How long will the program run?

The program will last 3 weeks, requiring the Jr. Counselor to commit to at least 3 weeks during our camp session.

What kind of training will a Jr. Counselor will receive?

The program here at Flying High is designed to teach responsibility, leadership, community involvement, team work, communication skills and counseling skills that can be used throughout

life. A successful participant will have shown to be enthusiastic, dedicated, hard-working, and devoted to our company's mission "creating individual experiences that are meaningful to every child."

Training will consist of, but is not limited to:

- Being matched with a Senior Counselor and shadowing him/her the entire duration of camp
- Direct feedback from the Senior Counselor they work with as well as the Camp Director
- Together with a Senior Counselor, plan the activities that will run on their day of choice related to the weekly theme
- Leadership Log- Each Jr. Counselor will keep a weekly Leadership Log tracking what
 they have taken in from leadership training, camp activities and other experiences at
 camp. The Camp Director will look over the logs and leave notes to track their progress
 and understanding.

Junior Camp Responsibilities:

The Jr Counselor will be subject to the same code of behavior and policies as regular program staff. Under the supervision of a Senior Counselor they will:

- Make camp a fun place to be!
- Welcome campers, assuring that every child is signed in/out for the day
- Enthusiastically participate in all camp activities
- Help with cleaning after activities, lunch time and snack time
- Help with set-up and take down during activities
- Help provide a safe and supportive atmosphere for campers
- Be alert about camper needs and discuss any problems with Senior Counselors or Camp Director
- Help campers resolve conflicts
- Be alert about equipment and our facility to ensure proper use, care and maintenance is adhered to; report repairs needed to Senior Counselor or Camp Director
- Ensure positive attitude, behavior, and interaction with campers and staff at all times
- Follow and uphold all safety rules and procedures
- Set a good example for campers and others with regards to general camp procedures and practices, including: sanitation, schedules, and sportsmanship
- Always work with a Senior Counselor or Camp Director to plan activities/games
- Work with Camp Director to learn the basics of child development, programming, supervision procedures, and policies
